In my capacity as Provost and Academic Pro-Rector of Central European University (CEU) in Budapest, Hungary, it is my pleasure to confirm our interest in the proposed FET Flagship FuturICT, within the Framework 8 program of the European Union.

CEU is impressed by the breadth and the interdisciplinary nature of the FuturICT project, aiming to take our understanding of socio-economic systems to a new level, by infusing the quantitative tools of natural sciences with the abundant data that is increasingly available about socio-economic systems.
